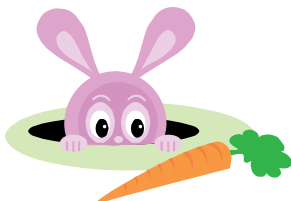


Bunny Ear Day

We have wonderful artists at NSES.

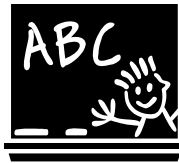
In April the students will be showcasing their art work for everyone to see.
