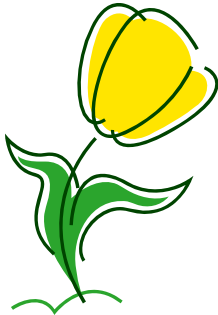

# RESPECT

## Seven Parenting Practices that Nurture Respect and Love

1. Treat your child as the most important person in the world. Make them feel valued and respected.
2. Give love with no strings attached. This doesn't mean you don't correct misbehavior—you need to but it means you still love them, even if they misbehave.
3. Listen attentively and respectfully. Encourage your child to talk to you and then stop and focus on what your child is saying to you.
4. Communicate with respect with your whole body, not just your words. Be careful what messages your eyes and body tell your child.
5. Build positive self-concepts. Don't use hurtful labels for your child.
6. Tell them often why you love and cherish them. The more you show your child you love him or her, the more your child learns to value and love him/herself.
7. Enjoy being together. Set aside time to be with your child, doing something they like.
